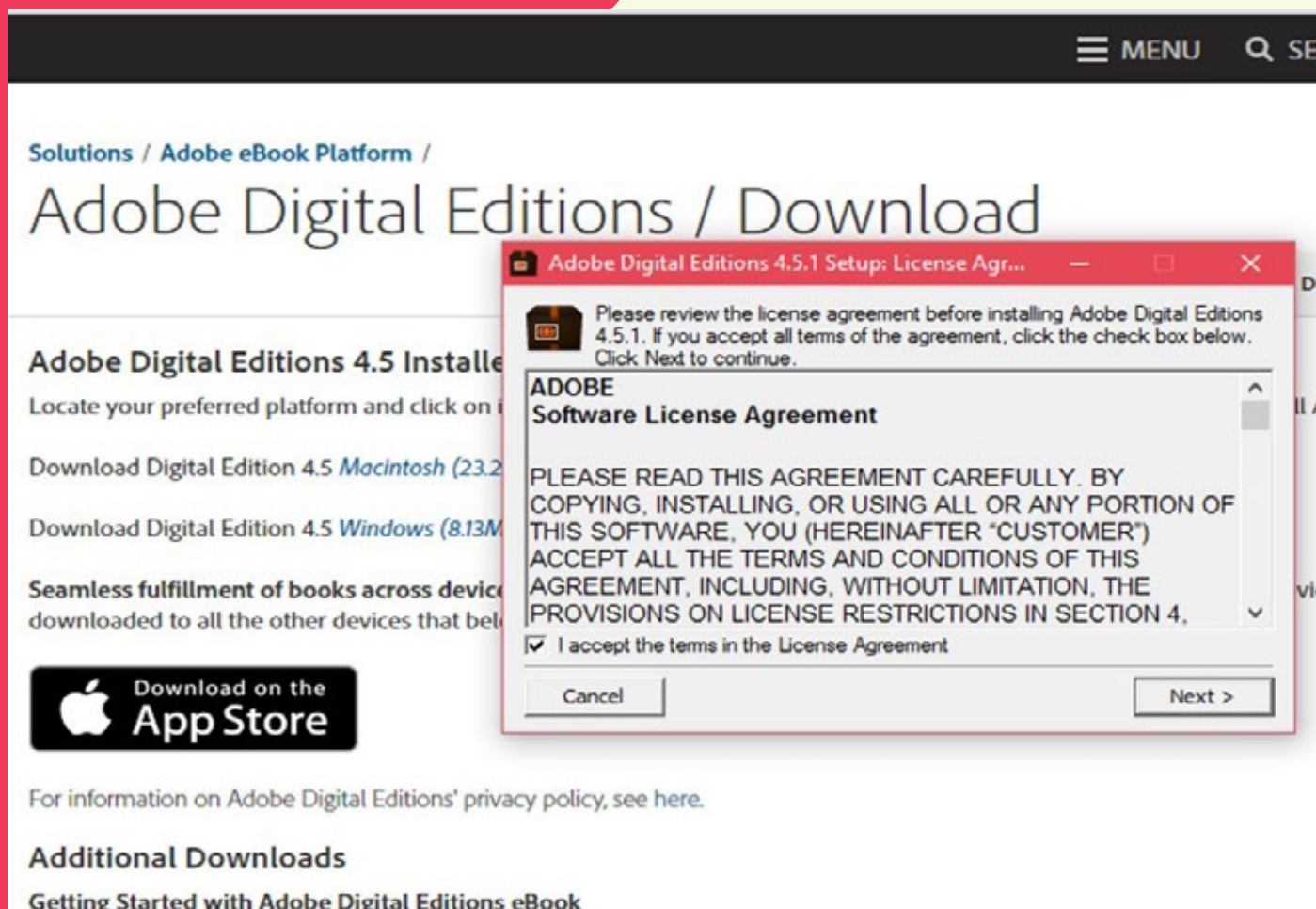


Ateneo de Manila University Press's e-books run on Adobe Digital Rights Management (Adobe DRM). You will need to register for an Adobe ID in order to view your e-books. Don't worry, **registration is free!**

The e-books download limit follows the limit of one Adobe ID: you can register six (6) devices to your Adobe ID that means you can also download your ebooks (infinite times) across six (6) devices. Follow the instructions below to register your device under your Adobe ID:



You can download Adobe Digital Editions for free through Adobe's website for desktop. It is also available on Google Play Store or iTunes for mobile.

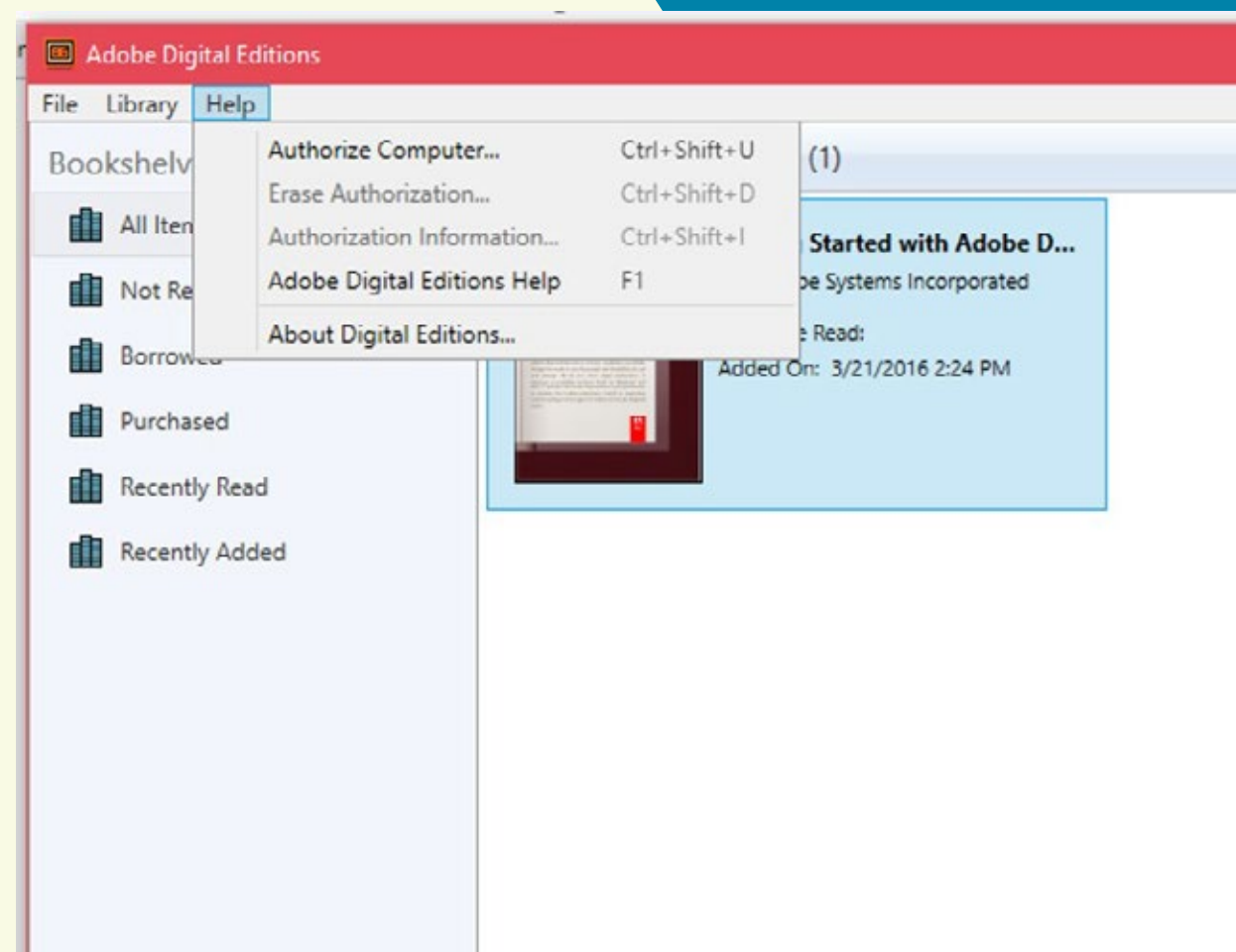
Download and install the program.

Open Adobe Digital Editions and go to the HELP tab on the menu bar.

Click "Authorize Computer..." to link your device to your Adobe account.

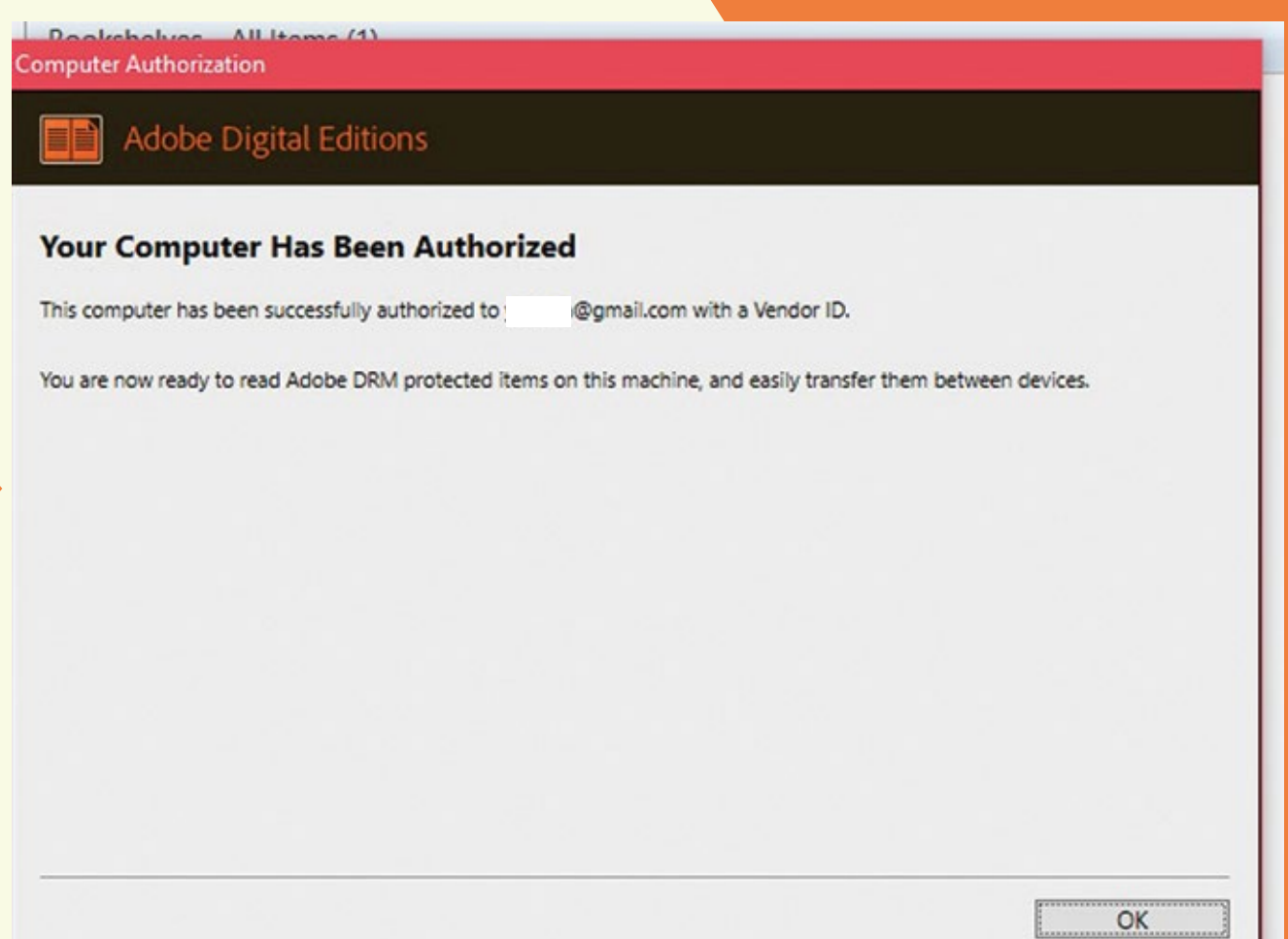
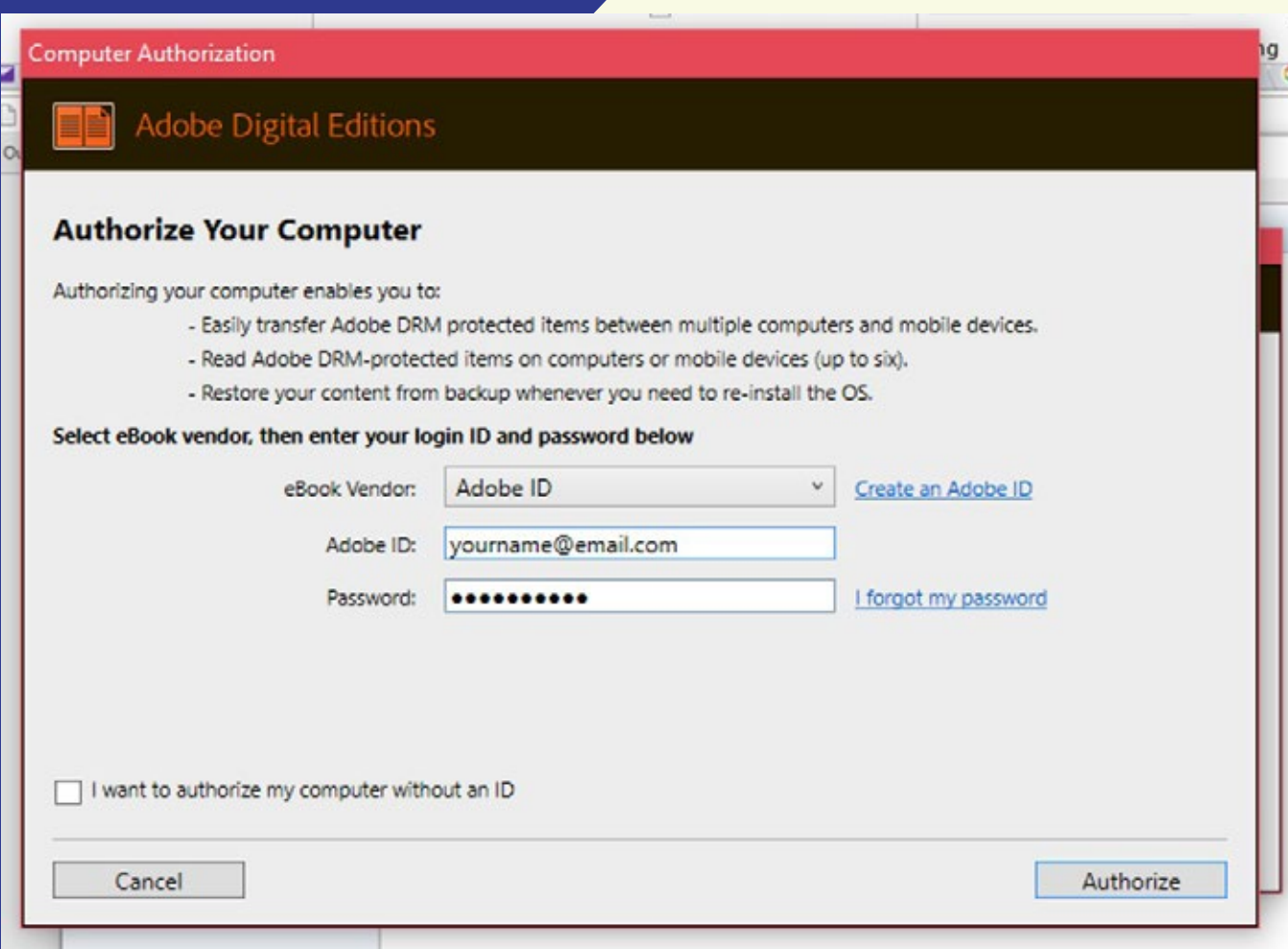
A dialogue box will appear. Make sure that the e-book Vendor box is set to "Adobe ID."

If you do not have an Adobe ID, you can click on the link "Create an Adobe ID" which will take you to the company's official webpage.

After creating an account, input your registered email and password.

Make sure that the box "I want to authorize my computer without an ID" remains unchecked.

You might encounter problems downloading the book from our site across different devices if you authorize your device manually or without an Adobe ID. Ideally, your e-book's Adobe DRM authorization should be linked to your ID so you can download it on any registered device.

Click "Authorize" and the dialogue box will confirm your request. Enjoy!
