

## PhD in Clinical Psychology

**Program Description & Objectives:** The PhD in Clinical Psychology program is primarily a clinical research program, the goal of which is to form psychology scholars who can contribute to building knowledge in Clinical Psychology.

**Target:** The program is intended for academics, teachers and researchers who wish to hone their skills in clinical psychology research.

**Admission Requirements:** An MA in Psychology or a graduate degree is required for admission into the PhD in Psychology program. If from an MA non-thesis program, the applicant must show evidence of research competence (papers generated during coursework). They need to take the Ateneo Graduate admission test, Critical Thinking test and MMPI test. Applicants also need to submit a Statement of Research Interest and identify a preferred mentor who will interview them before they are accepted into the program.
